Greetings. My name is Councilman Ralph Rodriguez Sr. I Drafted Hot Spot Saturday's nearly three years ago. As chair of the public safety committee, I felt the need to mitigate illegal dumping throughout our city. Rectifying illegal dumping, and restoring the beautification of the city is a top priority of mine. Passing the resolution unanimously through City council, HotSpot Saturday's was born. After two seasons and only twelve days of service, volunteers have been able to remove seventy tons of trash, waste, and illegal dumping materials out of our Neighborhoods. This is a huge win for the residents of the City of Harrisburg.

Through a partnership with LCSWMA, and the City of Harrisburg's Public works department, this initiative has been able to save the residents tens of thousands of dollars.
